Waste collection

Waste indicator

The digital waste guide shows when your waste will be collected or how you present your waste. We also collect waste that is harmful to the environment, such as small chemical waste. You register for the Waste App 'Waste Guide' from AddComm or via the website www.mijnWastewijzer.nl. After entering your zip code and house number you will receive a message when you have to put your waste on the road. For example on your mobile phone, tablet or via e-mail. In addition, the annual calendar of the waste guide can also be downloaded as a PDF.

Has your waste not been collected?

You report to the Public Space Reporting Point if your waste has not been collected. We ensure that the waste is collected from you as soon as possible.

Waste bags

The municipality has opted for the collection system with municipal waste bags to encourage waste separation. Waste separation is better for the environment, because less waste has to be incinerated. You also immediately save money with waste separation, because you have to buy fewer waste bags.

Municipal waste bags are more expensive than regular waste bags. The processing costs of the waste are included in the price of the waste bags.

In addition, every household in Putten receives a waste levy assessment. This charge is the same for everyone. The residents pay the waste levy. This is to pay the costs of equipment, personnel and general costs for waste collection.

Complaints about municipal waste bags

The quality of municipal waste bags is generally good, but the production process does not always run smoothly. It may happen that some bags are a little too narrow or have no bottom. Do you have complaints about a roll of waste bags? In that case, do not return to the shopkeeper, but hand in this roll to the Service Desk in the town hall. You will then receive a new roll.
